Your doctor would like you to have a **Gallium Scan**. The test is to assess soft tissue abnormalities such as infection.

Procedure: You are injected with a radioactive tracer.

The technologist taking your scan will let you know if you are to come back to the Department 24 or 48 hours after the initial injection. You may have to return a third time for more pictures.

Preparation: Nil.

An important note for women having Nuclear Medicine Scans:

As with any test using radiation, you must contact the Department of Nuclear Medicine before your appointment if:

- **You are or may be pregnant, or if you are breast feeding**
- **Please do not bring small children with you**
