- Academic research excellence with significant contributions and international recognition
- Leadership as a Head of Department or Research group
- •Research training and supervision of graduate students to successful careers
- •Member of staff at Austin-Mercy Health and Education Precinct at time of nomination

#### **NOMINATIONS**

Accompanying all nominations should be a brief summary (less than two A4 pages) describing how the nominee fits the criteria. Details should illustrate the candidate's research discoveries, their direct impact and broader implications.

Specific examples of the scale of nominee's

research achievements and extent of influence upon direction of research discipline are welcome.

Include a description of the nominee's collaborative capacity and contributions.

A copy of the nominee's CV (less than 10 pages) is required. A list of the most significant publications may be included

The selection committee reserves the right to not make an award if applications are not of sufficient standard.
