AIM

To honour a prominent researcher who has made an outstanding contribution to the research community at Austin Health.

SELECTION CRITERIA

- Academic research excellence with significant contributions and international recognition
- Leadership as a Head of Department or Research group
- Research training and supervision of graduate students to successful careers
- Member of staff at Austin LifeSciences alliance time of nomination.

NOMINATIONS

Accompanying all nominations should be a brief, (less than two A4 pages) summary as to how the nominee fits the criteria.

- Details should illustrate the candidate's research discoveries, their direct impact and broader implications.
- Specific examples of the scale of nominee's research achievements and extent of influence upon direction of research discipline are welcome.
- Include a description of the nominee's collaborative capacity and contributions.
- A copy of the nominee's CV (less than 10 pages) is required. A list of the most significant publications may be included

The nomination should be sent, by email marked confidential to: geraldine.richards@austin.org.au by 25 August 2023.

The selection committee reserves the right to not make an award if applications are not of sufficient standard.
