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# Diabetes Co-ordination Team

The Diabetes Coordination Team invites you to be part of a new diabetes service.

During your stay in hospital we will coordinate the management of your diabetes and help you to access preventative health services.

This brochure explains how the Diabetes Coordination Team can help you manage your diabetes in hospital, and at home.

### What is the Diabetes Coordination Team?

We are a team of diabetes professionals who can help you to manage your diabetes well.

Our team is made up of:

- Diabetes Care Co-ordinator
- Diabetes Specialist
- Diabetes Educator
- Dietitian
- Podiatrist

This service compliments other diabetes services within Austin Health and in the community. We try to involve your General Practitioner at all times.

## What does the Diabetes Coordination Team do?

During your hospital stay, the Diabetes Co-ordination Team will:

- 1. Thoroughly assess your diabetes.
- 2. Make sure your diabetes is managed well during your hospital stay. This may mean a review by a hospital diabetes specialist, diabetes educator, podiatrist or dietitian.

When you leave hospital, the Diabetes Co-ordination Team can:

- Put you in contact with diabetes services in your local area to ensure your diabetes continues to be well managed. This may include diabetes education and self-management programs.
- Make sure your diabetes is reassessed every year.

## **Diabetes Complications and Assessment Screen**

The Diabetes Co-ordination Team will assess your diabetes while you are in hospital. If you need a more detailed assessment the Team can arrange this with your GP after you leave, through the North East Diabetes Service (NEDS) at:
