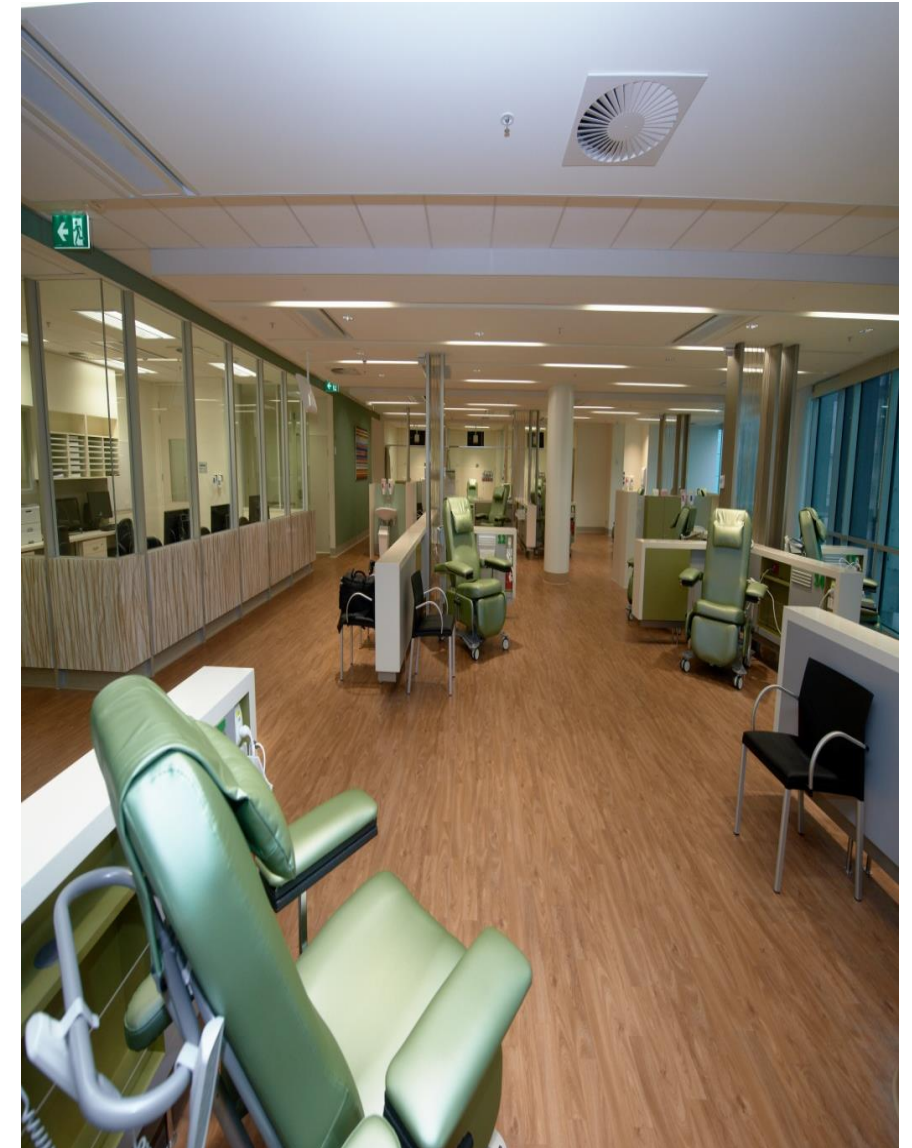

- **4 Registrars** (mixture of senior and junior haem trainees)
- **Rotate through**
 - Inpatient: leukaemia/allograft
 - Inpatients: the rest
 - Outpatient/clinical trials
 - Day oncology/referrals
- **Close interaction with laboratory team and CNCs**
- **Clinical spectrum:**
 - Leukaemia and lots of lymphoma
 - wide range of benign (including T+H) haematology
 - autografts and allografts (MUD/haplo)
 - perhaps CAR-T??????
- 1 in 4 weekends
- Afternoon off per week [not always!]
- Lots of clinic exposure.. T+H, lymphoma etc.
- Autonomy vs supervision



Teaching, Education, Research, Career Pathway



- Induction programme at the start
- Specific educational sessions per week:
 - **journal club**
 - **special interest group meetings eg molecular**
 - **formal specific registrar focused tutorials following college curriculum**
 - **alternate Monday pm with Head of Dept**
 - **unit meetings (pathology, radiology etc.) and numerous MDMs**
- Each registrar responsible for and *mentored* in at least one research study
- Resident and student teaching
- Attend at least one national or international conference
- Transition into laboratory position if you're lucky!
