

Transition to Specialty Practice: Spinal



ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The Transition to Specialty Practice Program: The Spinal TSP is designed to introduce registered nurses to spinal nursing. Spinal at Austin Health is a state-wide service that is part of the Victorian State Trauma System. The program offers experiential learning, study days, rotations in acute and readmission and, rehabilitation. Concepts explored will be autonomic dysfunction, advanced respiratory management, neurogenic bladder and bowel management, and complex discharge planning.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES

- Participants will develop and demonstrate the capacity to think critically and develop specific nursing skills in the spinal nursing specialty
- Participants will demonstrate an alignment of clinical and theoretical knowledge while planning and implementing the care of the patient requiring spinal services

WHO SHOULD APPLY

- Registered Nurse with minimum of 12 months acute clinical experience
- Registration with Nursing and Midwifery Board of Australia (NMBA)
- Applications from 2021 Graduate Nurse Program participants are welcomed
