The Florey Institute of Neuroscience & Mental Health Prize for Neuroscience Research

AIM

To encourage an early career neuroscience researcher to further his/her/their research career by enabling attendance at a national or international scientific meeting*, lab visit or professional development.

Awards are support for researchers to attend conferences or training. Attendance at conferences where the awardee is making a presentation (poster or oral) will be more favourably received. Registration fees, training course fees, travel costs and a per diem rate as currently determined by the Australian Taxation Office (to cover accommodation and meals) can be claimed for these awards.

*scientific meeting includes conference/scientific day/lab visit where a presentation is made to lab.

SELECTION CRITERIA

- Early career researcher; within 10 years post PhD (or highest degree)
- Quality of abstract submitted for ResearchFest
- Neuroscience Research

PRIZE

\$1000 reimbursement of costs associated with attendance at a national or international meeting or lab visit (should the COVID-19 situation permit), and/or for use in professional development.

Presentation will be made during ResearchFest 2022 at the plenary webinar, Thursday 20 October 2022, applicants are expected to be present.

The award should be redeemed before April 2024.
