Students complete coursework and clinical hurdles in a structured program with our dedicated education team. Students will gain the skills to deliver high quality care to both adult and paediatric patients by participating in a supported assessment program of clinical hurdles, study days with simulation education, clinical skills stations and structured learning with supported shifts throughout the program.

## LEARNING OBJECTIVES

Students will develop advanced clinical patient assessment skills for adult and paediatric patients.

Students will develop advanced critical care skills in the area of emergency nursing, including resuscitation and triage.

Students will be an integral member of a large, dynamic, multidisciplinary team of Emergency clinicians.

Registered nurses with 2 years acute experience, who are motivated to deliver outstanding patient care in a dynamic environment.
