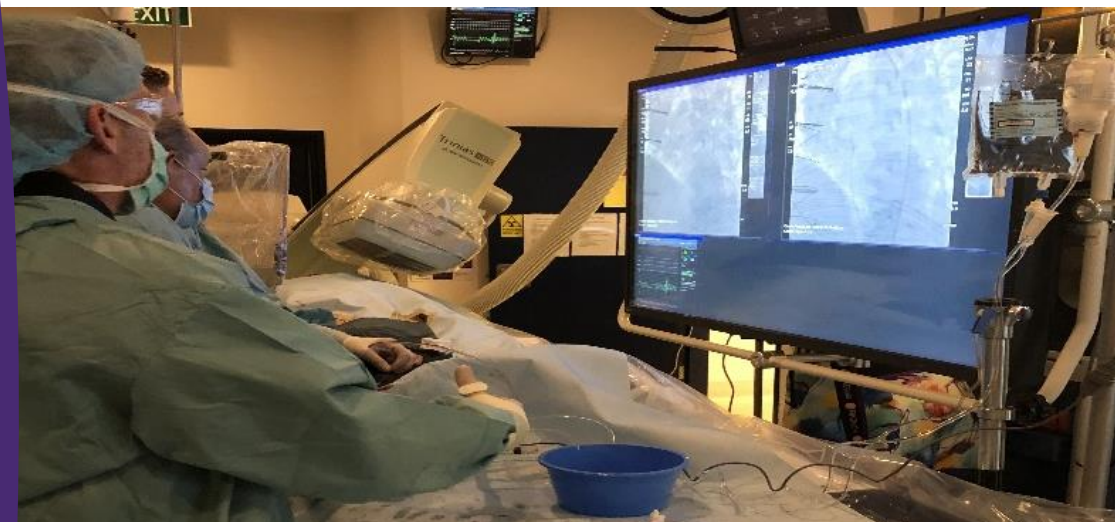


Graduate Certificate of Nursing Practice (Cardiac Care: Interventional Cardiology)
