Austin Health, in collaboration with an affiliated Melbourne tertiary hospital, are offering registered nurses the opportunity to undertake a Graduate Certificate in Clinical Nursing (Neuroscience), in conjunction with our partner, Australian Catholic University (ACU). Students complete coursework and clinical assessments both face to face and online in a structured program whilst working in the neuroscience area. Clinical support is provided by our dedicated nursing education team.
