Students' complete coursework online and clinical assessments face-to-face in a structured program whilst working in renal clinical areas. Clinical support is provided by our dedicated nursing education team.

Austin Health's renal service incorporates inpatient renal care, including renal transplant and nurse-led peritoneal dialysis. Haemodialysis is offered extensively in both inpatient and community patient settings. This program allows you to gain experience in all of these clinical areas.
