ABOUT THE PROGRAM

Students within the Respiratory Foundations program will undertake a program of study days and clinical skill development over a 6 month period. This will include an introduction to care of non-invasively ventilated patients and high dependency nursing care skills. The dynamic ward environment includes the VRSS and Ventilation weaning unit and respiratory HDU areas

LEARNING OBJECTIVES

- Students will develop advanced respiratory assessment skills.
- Students will develop strong respiratory care skills in the area of respiratory HDU. Nurses will be given the opportunity to care for non-invasively ventilated patients with support.

- RN with minimum 12 months experience.
