- Have raised blood sugar levels
- Are overweight
- Are taking only a stable dose of **Metformin** to treat your Type 2 Diabetes (you can be taking medication to treat other medical conditions)
- Are not on Insulin
- Are in good health or have medical conditions that are well controlled

The study involves:

- Attending multiple clinic appointments to see our Doctor over a 6-month period
- Keeping a daily diary
- * *There will be no additional costs to you for your participation in this research study*
- ** *You will be reimbursed for any reasonable travel or parking costs.*
