- fluent in English.

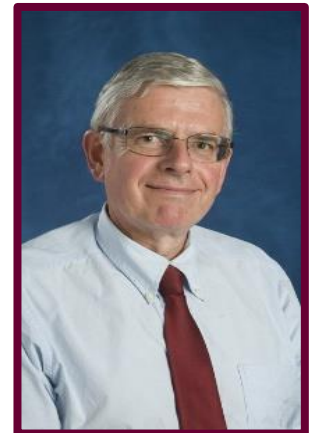
