

Palliative Care Referral Guidelines

Austin Health Palliative Care Clinic holds one session per week to discuss and plan the treatment of patients with palliative conditions

Department of Health clinical urgency categories for Specialist Clinics

Urgent: If the patient has the potential to deteriorate quickly, with significant consequences for health and quality of life. These patients should be seen **within 30 days**. For emergency cases please send the patient to the Emergency department.

Semi Urgent: Semi Urgent: Referrals should be categories as Semi Urgent that has the potential to deteriorate within 30-90 days.

Routine: If the patient's condition is unlikely to deteriorate quickly or have significant consequences for the person's health and quality of life if specialist assessment is delayed beyond one month.

Exclusions:

Patients not previously known to Austin Health.

Not appropriate for patients with Chronic Pain Syndromes – Refer to the Austin Chronic Pain Clinic

Non-ambulant patients – patients requiring ambulance transport should be reviewed in their homes by the Community Palliative Care Service.

Establishing treatment plan and discharge back to Referrer Securing patient/family confidence and understanding of care needs 	1-4 appointments will usually be required.
